

## **ANNOUNCEMENT – CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS**

To honour the memory of our friend and colleague Mariangela Tempera, IASEMS is pleased to announce the following award:

## The IASEMS 'Mariangela Tempera' Book Prize for Early Modern English Studies 2018

IASEMS will award a triennial prize of 3000 euro for a book published by one of its members in the area of Early Modern English Studies (1485-1700). The area of research includes the whole of the British Isles. Books should be scholarly monographs or critical editions, written in English or Italian, and should be published in one of the three years prior to the year for which the prize is awarded (2015-2017, up to and including January 2018).

Please note that:

- All entries must be provided with ISBN or equivalent.
- Books should not be previous award-winners.
- Edited collections of essays are not accepted.

**Candidates** for the award should be IASEMS members, and under 40 years of age. **Deadline for application**: January 31<sup>st</sup> 2018.

The application should include:

The candidate's personal data and short cv

Complete bibliographic details

Scan-copy of the candidate's passport or identity card.

Please send your application to Alessandra Petrina (alessandra.petrina@unipd.it) and Mariacristina Cavecchi (cristina.cavecchi@unimi.it). All applicants will receive a confirmation e-mail. Do not send the book at this stage.

Notifications of interest after the deadline will not be considered.

The IASEMS Board will appoint a selection committee of three members for each prize. Candidates will be given the names and addresses of the three members of the board of judges with specific instructions.

The 2018 award will be announced at the annual IASEMS Conference in Cagliari (13-15 June, 2018).
