2027 BURSARIES FOR EARLY-CAREER IASEMS MEMBERS

The Italian Association of Shakespearean and Early Modern Studies is accepting applications for bursaries to support the participation of early-career members (i.e. PhD students and candidates, post-doctoral and research fellows within five years of the award of their PhD) in the IASEMS Tempera Early-Career Research Forum 2027 (IASEMS Tempera Seminar 2027, University of Padova, 7-9 June 2027).

IASEMS will fund **3** bursaries of **200 euros** each.

Eligibility requirements:

- 1) applicants must be IASEMS members in good standing with the payment of the annual fee (30 euros for junior scholars);
- 2) applicants must have had a submission accepted at the IASEMS Mariangela Tempera Early-Career Research Forum;
- 3) applicants should not hold a permanent academic position (lecturer, associate or full professor).

Applications – to be filled out using the attached form – should be sent to **info@iasems.org**, along with a CV, a copy of a valid ID, and the abstract of the paper to be presented, by no later than 15 April 2027.

Preference will be given to those who have not received a bursary in previous years.

Once completed applications are received, materials will be reviewed promptly by the IASEMS Executive Board. All efforts will be made to provide a decision to the applicant within two weeks.

The bursary recipients are expected to attend the whole Conference (IASEMS Tempera Seminar 2027 and IASEMS Mariangela Tempera Early-Career Research Forum). The bursaries will be paid after the conclusion of the Conference
